We are very excited to invite you to our Feis in Prague. We decided to fill the gap between the Vienna Feis and the Oireachtas in Brasov, and therefore we changed this year's theme. We cannot wait to see all our dancing friends again at our Gall-Tír Academy Halloween Feis 2024.

The Feis is being held in the capital city Prague which is well connected with three other European capitals – Bratislava (333 km), Vienna (340 km) and Berlin (350 km). The nearest airport is Václav Havel Prague Airport (30 min. drive or 40 min. public transport to the center) with regular low costs and standard flights from most of the European cities.

Our venue is a sports hall that many of you are already familiar with and it has many changing rooms, a warm-up area and a results hall. The hall is located in Prague 4 (District Pankrác).

We are happy that we can offer great refreshments from [edortiky.cz](http://edortiky.cz) which got a positive response in the last two years.

The Feis will offer Grade competitions and Adult/Open Championships. There will be a trophy for all first places and medals for all till 8th place (for all in Reel and Trophy comp.). In Traditional Set dances, Trophy dances and Open solos first three places will receive a trophy.

**There will be no limit for entries, but we would like to ask all teachers to register their dancers in advance so we can modify the timetable accordingly.**

We are looking forward to seeing you all in Prague and wish the very best of luck to those competing at our Feis!

# Rialacha NaFeis - Feis Rules


1. The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha.
2. Entries will be accepted from persons currently registered with An Coimisiún.
2. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
3. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
4. Age will be taken as on 1st January 2024. Whatever age a dancer turns this year in 2024, he/she will dance under that age all year long, e.g. if a dancer's date of birth is 29 May 2013 he/she dances under 11 in the year 2024). Evidence of age may be requested, therefore dancers from Mainland Europe should have a valid ID with them in the event of a query as to their age.
5. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
6. Beginners Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize in any competition for that particular dance (please refer to the grid). In Beginners Grade competitions only basic steps may be performed.
7. Primary Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance other than in Beginners Grade.
8. Intermediate Grade competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won 1st or 2nd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance in Intermediate under the same or higher age limits. If a dancer in Continental Europe and Asia wins in Intermediate, they advance to the next level for the rest of the calendar year. Teachers can move dancers back at their own discretion at the start of the next calendar year.

9. For all Beginner, Primary, Intermediate competitions the 32 bar method will be applied. In Beginner/Primary/Intermediate trophy competitions 16 bars are required. However, the number of bars to be danced may be lowered if this seems indicated to the organizers.
10. All Open Championship dancers will be required to dance 48 bars of music in the reel and jig and 40 bars in the slip-jig and hornpipe. Dancers competing in the U7 Championship will dance 3 light rounds of 32 bars each. If there are more than 9 dancers in any age group, the third round may be danced as a recall at the final discretion of the organisers.
11. Adult Preliminary Championships are open to Intermediate/Open level dancers who have never won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in Open Championship level and to dancers not participating in a full Open Championship at the same feis. Dancers will be required to dance 32 bars of music in the reel (gents, ladies) or slip-jig (ladies) in the light round, heavy jig or hornpipe in the heavy round, and a Traditional Set. If there are more than 9 dancers in any age group, the third round may be danced as a recall at the final discretion of the organisers. *Please note that these championships have been created for dancers who started Irish Dancing as ADULTS.*
12. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún, the organizers may at their discretion cancel or combine competitions with insufficient entries.
13. Two and three hands are danced to 40 bars of music. Ceilí and figure dances are subject to the rules applied at Oireachtas.
14. Traditional Set Dance competitions are a choice out of 7 traditional dances: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Jockey to the Fair and Three Sea Captains. If a dancer wins first place in any traditional set dance competition, he/she moves on to the next level in all 7 traditionals. Traditional set dances can only be performed in the Traditional Set competitions, in the Adult Championship and in the Under 10/Under 12 Open Championships.
15. Order and quiet must be kept in the hall, particularly while competitors are dancing.
16. Provided that dancers are not disturbed by flashlights or the like, photography or video recording by persons other than official feis photographers is allowed during Beginners and Primary competitions and during all award ceremonies.  
**Taking video/photo during Intermediate or Open competitions is prohibited!**

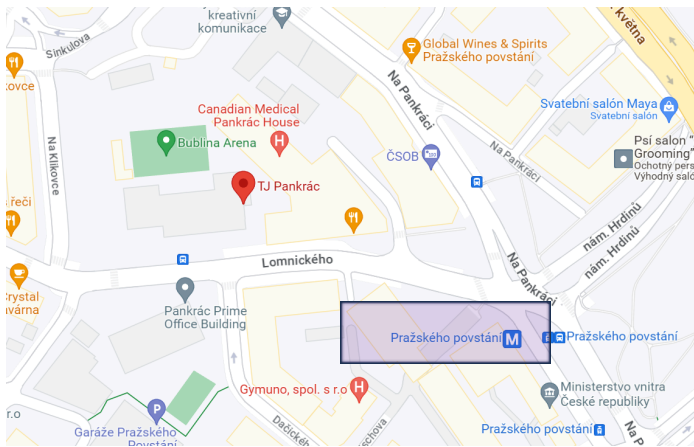

17. **Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes** before their competitions are scheduled. It can happen that the competitions start 30 minutes ahead of scheduled time.
  18. The Feis organizers cannot accept any liability for injury or loss or damage to property while on the premises.
  19. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions.
  20. The dress code in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed.
  19. All Beginners and Primary dancers of all age groups may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt and top/blouse, simple dress for girls and ladies, trousers and t-shirt/shirt for boys and gents). Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.
  20. Costume Length: Length of costumes must adhere to principles of modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may ask a competitor to change into black tights (of a denier not less than 70 per cent) in order for the dancer to continue in the competition. When wearing body suits with skirts (commonly known as black-out attire) black tights (of a denier less than 70) must be worn from the age of 14 and above. Effective date: 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2020 For details of approved costume features, please refer to the Costume Rules on [www.clrg.ie](http://www.clrg.ie).
  21. Female Adult dancers participating in competitions entitled 'adult grade competitions' (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier no less than 70. CLRG ruling March 2015.
  22. An Coimisiún has ruled that from 1st January each year, that **no block, en pointe**, stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. **The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.**
  23. By entering in competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public Internet archives.
  24. No refunds will be made unless the feis is cancelled.
  25. Music will be played at the recognized An Coimisiún speeds of Mainland Europe.
