Dear teachers, dancers and parents

We are very excited to invite you to our first feis in Prague. We cannot wait to see all our dancing friends again. The feis is being held in the capital city Prague which is well connected with three other European capitals – Bratislava (333 km), Vienna (340 km) and Berlin (350 km). The nearest airport is Václav Havel Prague Airport (30 min. drive or 40 min public transport to the centre) with regular low costs and standard flights from most of the European cities.

The venue will be in the beautiful building of the Prague district Karlín, offering free parking places nearby, a large feis hall with a 5x10m floor, two changing rooms and a warm up area. The feis will be run on one floor only and will offer grade competitions and open solo competitions.

There will be trophies for all first places and medals for runners up. In Traditional set dances, Trophy dances and Open solos first three places will receive a trophy.

Due to capacity reasons and local mass gatherings restrictions the max. number of 150 competitors will be limited and entries will close after this number is reached. A waiting list will be arranged in case of cancellations. Covid-19 government restrictions will be adhered to.

We are looking forward to seeing you all in Prague and wish the very best of luck to those competing at our feis!

Dancers' numbers will be available for collection by teachers or school representatives - the fee for the entire school must be paid beforehand.

Rialacha NaFeis - Feis Rules

1. The Feis will run in accordance with the Rules of An Coimisiún Le Rincí Gaelacha.
2. Entries will be accepted from persons currently registered with An Coimisiún.
2. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
3. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
4. Age will be taken as on 1st January 2022. Whatever age a dancer turns this year in 2022, he/she will dance under that age all year long, e.g. if a dancer's date of birth is 29 May 2012, he/she dances under 10 in the year 2022). Evidence of age may be requested, therefore dancers from Mainland Europe should have a valid ID with them in the event of a query as to their age.
5. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
6. Beginners Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st 2nd or 3rd prize in any competition for that particular dance (please refer to the grid). In Beginners Grade competitions only basic steps may be performed.
7. Primary Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st 2nd or 3rd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance other than in Beginners Grade.
8. Intermediate Grade competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won 1st or 2nd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance in Intermediate under the same or higher age limits. If a dancer in Continental Europe and Asia wins in Intermediate, they advance to the next level for the rest of the calendar year. Teachers can move dancers back at their own discretion at the start of the next calendar year.

9. For all Beginner, Primary, Intermediate and Open competitions the 32 bar method will be applied. In Beginner/Primary/Intermediate trophy competitions 16 bars are required.
10. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún, the organisers may at their discretion cancel or combine competitions with insufficient entries.
11. Order and quiet must be kept in the hall, particularly while competitors are dancing.
12. Traditional Set Dance competitions are a choice out of 7 traditional dances: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of the Fairies, Jockey to the Fair and Three Sea Captains. If a dancer wins first place in any traditional set dance competition, he/she moves on the next level in all 7 traditionals.
13. Provided that dancers are not disturbed by flashlights or the like, photography or video recording by persons other than official feis photographers is allowed during Beginners and Primary competitions and during all award ceremonies. During Intermediate and Open Championships competitions, this is reserved to any official feis photographer if present on site.
14. **Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled. It can happen that the competitions will start 30minutes ahead of scheduled time.**
15. The Feis organisers cannot accept any liability for injury or loss or damage to property while on the premises.
16. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions.
17. The dress code in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed.
19. All Beginners and Primary dancers of all age groups may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt and top/blouse, simple dress for girls and ladies, trousers and t-shirt/shirt for boys and gents). Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.

20. **Costume Length:** Length of costumes must adhere to principles of modesty and enable dancers to safely execute their movements and steps. Adjudicators who determine a costume to be too short or to lack modesty may ask a competitor to change into black tights (of a denier not less than 70 per cent) in order for the dancer to continue in the competition. When wearing body suits with skirts (commonly known as black-out attire) black tights (of a denier less than 70) must be worn from the age of 14 and above. Effective date: 1st February, 2020 For details of approved costume features, please refer to the Costume Rules on www.clr.org.
21. Female Adult dancers participating in competitions entitled ‘adult grade competitions’ (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier no less than 70. CLRG ruling March 2015.
22. An Coimisiún has ruled that from 1st January each year, that **no block, en pointe**, stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. **The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.**
23. By entering in competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public Internet archives.
24. No refunds will be made unless the feis is cancelled.
25. In case the government mass gathering restrictions will require so, the feis organizers might ask all the participants (including non dancers) to provide their name and email contact for Covid 19 tracing.
26. Music will be played at the recognized An Coimisiún speeds of Mainland Europe.

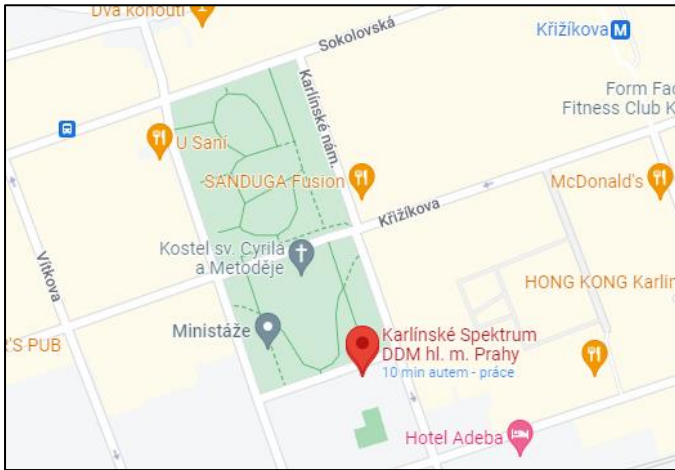
